The National Society of Black Engineers at the University of Houston and The Henry Foundation (THF) have partnered together to support THF's mission to increase the number of scholarship opportunities available to international students. Recipients will be evaluated in the following areas:

- Submitted application
- NSBE involvement
- Financial need
- Community service

THF scholarships are awarded annually at the NSBE Fall Banquet and scholarship amounts range from \$1,000 - \$1,500. If you are interested in applying, please review the requirements below. Applications are accepted until **November 1st**.

Eligibility Requirements

- **International:** An international student on a student visa (F-1 or other related student visas) with proof of status.
- **Membership:** Must be an **active** UH NSBE paid member.
- **Academic:** Earning a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- **Demonstrates a need for financial assistance.**
- **Current Undergraduate or Graduate:** A current undergraduate or graduate student that is actively enrolled in a STEM related discipline program at the University of Houston.

Application Requirements

Applications must be submitted with all required documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered. A complete application consists of:

- Proof of enrollment
- Proof of visa status
- Unofficial transcript
- Brief personal statements on the following topics (maximum 250 words each):
 1. What motivates you?
 2. How do you motivate others around you?
 3. How would this scholarship impact you?
